THE HOUSE OF LOVE follow up their Top 30 single 'Shine On' with a new 45 'The Beatles And The Stones', released on Fontana on Monday.

And for the ardent fans of **Guy Chadwick** (pictured right) there's a whole list of limited edition versions of the 45 available in the first week. The shopping list includes a seven-inch box set with colour poster, a 12 inch with bonus track, an acoustic version of 'Phone' and a CD with extra song 'Marble'.

'The Beatles And The Stones' has been remixed by Dave Bascombe from the group's current LP 'Fontana'.

The B-side tracks, including the standard seven inch B-side 'Love IV' are the first to feature new guitarist Simon Walker, the replacement for Terry Bickers.

The limited edition formats will also be, we're promised, "very" limited and individually numbered



to ensure total collectability.

House Of Love raised over £1,000 for a school mini-bus appeal in Pontefract last week when they played live at the Minthorpe School, South Elmsall, South Yorks.

The band were first approached to play the benefit by fans from the school at a recent HOL gig in Wakefield. They presented Guy Chadwick with a petition signed by pupils and a video of a successful charity event they'd organised last Autumn featuring CUD.

Tickets were £2.50 but some wily pupils were scalping them for up to £10 a time. Presumably they are now doing detention.

Support at the gig came from hip school band Nigel's Bees whose set included covers of Who, Sweet, and Spacemen 3 songs.
